<u>Provincial Outreach Program for</u> <u>Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (POPFASD)</u>

Mandate: To increase educators' capacity to meet the educational needs of students

with Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder.

Our Team: 3 Teachers, 1 Technical Analyst, 0.5 Office Administrator

*We are guided by a 9 member provincial Steering Committee

**We are Ministry of Education funded and hosted in SD57 (Prince George).

Services: Workshops:

POPFASD provides FASD workshops to interested BC school district groups. These workshops are organized through the designated District Partner (see information below). We provide these workshops at no cost to the district.

FASDcasts:

POPFASD uses webcasting technology to deliver FASD workshops to BC school staffs, student teams, specific district groups, and multiple school sites in a district. Again, there is no charge for our FASDcasts.

Online FASDclass:

POPFASD provides an introductory online FASDclass for any BC educator. Our online course provides an interactive experience that encourages the connection between the information about FASD and current teaching practice. The course is 4 modules in length and is free to BC educators.

Collaborative Action Research Study (CARS) grants:

POPFASD provides up to \$5000 for educators to carry out action research projects. We encourage educators to identify a need in their school(s) and to use the grant money to provide opportunities for educators to collaborate and develop solutions. The project work is always shared provincially.

<u>District</u> Partners: We have a designated educator(s) in each of our province's 60 public school districts and many of our independent school groups as well. Our District Partners typically take on this role voluntarily and act as a liaison between their district and POPFASD.
